## Prayer Ministry Available Today

Healing Prayer Ministry is available after the service in the South Porch. There will be two people available to pray with you or for your loved ones.

Sometimes people are looking for God's forgiveness and are in need of help to forgive others. Whatever the reason, please do take advantage of the chance to receive prayer from our prayer ministry team and be assured that anything you share will be treated in complete confidence.
