Electoral Roll



Every six years, we are required to compile a new Electoral Roll for the parish from scratch and 2019 is one of those years! To be on the roll, you have to be 16 or over and either a resident of the parish or a regular worshipper at St Mary's. Even if you are already on the current (2013) roll, you still need to apply to be on the new one. Inclusion on the roll enables you to vote at the Annual Church meeting, to stand for election to the PCC and determines how many representatives the church is allowed on Deanery and Diocesan bodies.

Forms for inclusion on the roll are now at the back of the church, so please do take one, complete it and return it to Sue Ryman, the Church Electoral Roll Officer as soon as possible. The new roll will be completed around mid- March. Thank you!
